She was contributing editor and Dear Garbage columnist for the national magazine *Garbage* (recycling and features), and has written for *Dallas Morning News* (recycling), *Dallas Observer* (music and comedy), TheaterJones (comedy, magic and cirque), and *D* magazine and *Dallas Times Herald* (performing arts).

For a dozen years, Martin operated an alternative news service called Moonlady News from her nickname. A leader in Earth-centered and unaffiliated spirituality, Martin was director of Earth Rhythms and creator of acclaimed Summer and Winter SolstiCelebrations for 20 years.

For 12 years, Martin managed a private nature preserve where she converted 15 acres into tallgrass prairie and rehabilitated wildlife habitat. She now volunteers in the Dixon Branch Greenbelt of her [Eastwood](#) neighborhood and for [North Texas Master Naturalists](#).
